- Be courteous and aware of all skaters and coaches at all times.

Music Rules

- A music playing commitment is standard practice and mandatory for parents in all skating clubs across Canada. Parents will be slotted in for their music session on a rotating basis, based on the number of skaters/sessions for each session that their child skates on. Music is at ice level. If you are unable to fulfill your music commitment, it is your responsibility to find a replacement to play your music session.
- Solo music is played in order. If a skater refuses their music their name goes to the bottom of the list.
- Only solo's requested by a coach will be played out of order.
- Skaters are not to request their music, it will be played in order.
- Respond promptly when your solo is called.
- Buy-on's will have their music played after all others on the session.


